Students can take the seven courses in Applied Behavior Analysis as part of the 36-hr degree program in special education. Coursework emphasizes low incidence disabilities and autism

- A 2.8 GPA (4.0 scale), on last 60 hours of courses before earning the bachelor's degree or at least 2.5 GPA on all previous college studies.
- Official scores from standardized tests such as the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Miller's Analogies Test (MAT).
